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Vulnerable Persons Registry

This registry promotes communication between vulnerable persons, the people who support them, and emergency responders. The goal is to provide responders with quick access to critical information in an emergency.

A vulnerable person is one who, due to medical, cognitive, mental health or physical condition, may pose a danger to themselves or require extra help in an emergency. Examples include persons with autism, dementia, blindness or deafness, cerebral palsy, Parkinson's disease, or those who are wheelchair bound or have conditions that may cause physical instability, communication issues or irrational fears.

We are asking for the name and address of any person you feel may benefit. We don't need to know about their condition or disability. We don't need to know your name. We will contact the person or caregiver directly. When a vulnerable person is thought to be at risk during an emergency such as wildfire or flood, *only then* will their personal information be shared with relevant persons. This registry is completely voluntary.
